GENERAL BOARD MEETING

- 9 1. Call public meeting to order
- David Sweet, President of the ESC, called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. with the above listed board members being present and absent.

- 14 Sweet asked if anyone would like to come forth and speak at this time. There being no one indicating such,

- 16 3. DISCUSS / ACT ON APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES FROM THE JULY 24, 2019 REGULAR ES CORP. BOARD MEETING
- 17 Board Member New moved to approve the minutes as presented. Board Member Sherrill seconded the
- motion, which passed unanimously of those present (Bloom asbsent).
- 19 4. DISCUSS / ACT ON ES CORP. TREASURER'S REPORT
- 20 Treasurer of the ESC, David Peek, came forth and briefed the board on his monthly report. Board
- 21 Member Johannesen moved to accept the report as presented. Board Member Billings seconded the
- 22 motion, which passed unanimously of those present (Bloom absent).
- 23 5. HEAR UPDATE REGARDING THE PROPOSED ES CORPORATION BUDGETS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020
- 24 Mary Smith, Assistant City Manager / Finance Director of Rockwall, came forth and indicated that budgets
- 25 were distributed month before last to all member jurisdictions. So far, she has not received any questions

- or heard of any opposition to said budget proposals. The ES Corp. Board will take action to adopt the budgets at its regular board meeting at the end of Sept. (next month).
- **6.** DISCUSS / ACT ON EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RELATED TOPICS, INCLUDING THE FOLLOWING:
 - A) MONTHLY EMERGENCY MGMT. PROGRAM REPORT

Jarod Rosson, Deputy Emergency Mgmt. Coordinator for Rockwall County, briefed the board on his department's monthly reports for July. He filled the board in on recent ransomware attacks that have affected small municipalities / jurisdictions within the last week or two. He went on to speak about the importance of cybersecurity preparedness, prevention and training, letting attendees know of an IT working group through the N. Central TX Council of Governments (NCTCOG). Barbara Neville, Rockwall Co. Emergency Mgmt. Coordinator, shared that she will soon begin meeting with countywide Emergency Mgmt. Coordinators, city managers and elected officials, as well as IT staff, to open dialogue related to emergency management preparedness efforts. She also mentioned that the state Division of Emergency Mgmt. offers free cybersecurity training for local jurisdictions, so some of these will be scheduled in the future. Mrs. Neville spoke about her annual Emergency Mgmt. strategic plan, proposing that she bring that forth to the board for discussion and consideration at the Oct. ES Corp. board meeting. The board seemed generally agreeable to her doing so in Oct.

B) G-200 TEXAS PUBLIC OFFICIALS WORKSHOP

Indication was given that every elected official is supposed to sit through a minimum of three hours of emergency management training, and this course meets that requirement. This course will be scheduled for Wed., Oct. 16 in the evening time, and it will be held at Liberty Hall at the (newer) county courthouse. All elected officials, countywide, will be invited and highly encouraged to attend. More details will be forthcoming from the County Office of Emergency Management.

- C) ANNUAL EMERG. MGMT. AGREEMENT BETWEEN COUNTY AND ESC
- Sweet invited anyone who may have comments pertaining to this agreement to email those to him soon. He will then work with the ESC's legal counsel, Grant Brenna, to bring back this annual agreement for board consideration at the Sept. board meeting. Board Member Billings suggested that wording related to the hiring of the emergency management personnel be clarified. Also, he believes that 'equivalent experience' should be worked in to the language under Section 4a (1-2). In addition, the title "Emergency Management Specialist" needs to be changed to "Deputy Emergency Management Coordinator."
