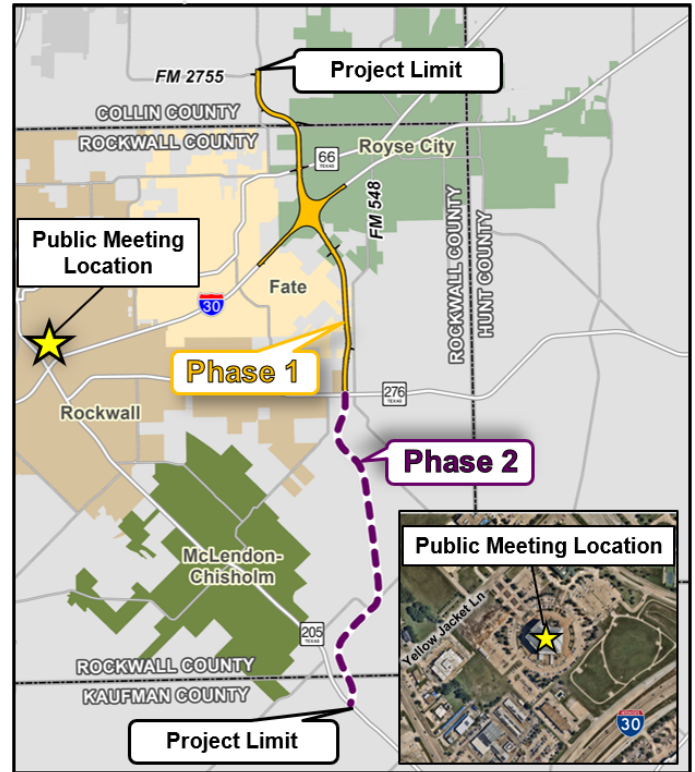


Rockwall County Outer Loop Project Virtual Public Meeting with In-Person Option

Rockwall County is proposing a new location roadway from FM 2755 to SH 205, a distance of approximately 14.4 miles in Collin, Rockwall, and Kaufman Counties, Texas.

The proposed project would construct the Rockwall County portion of the regional Outer Loop, consisting of four 12-foot-wide frontage road lanes (two in each direction), four 12-foot-wide general purpose lanes (two in each direction), and two 10-foot-wide shared-use paths (one in each direction, outside the frontage road lanes) within a typical 500-foot-wide right of way. The project would be constructed in phases contingent on traffic volumes and available funding.

The purpose of the public meeting is to provide an update on project progress and request public feedback. The same information will be available at both the virtual and in-person meetings.
