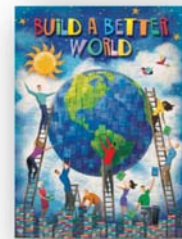
Adult Summer Reading continues through August 5th.

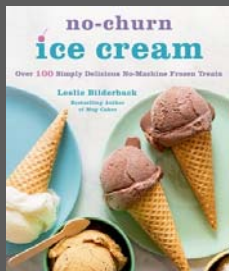
