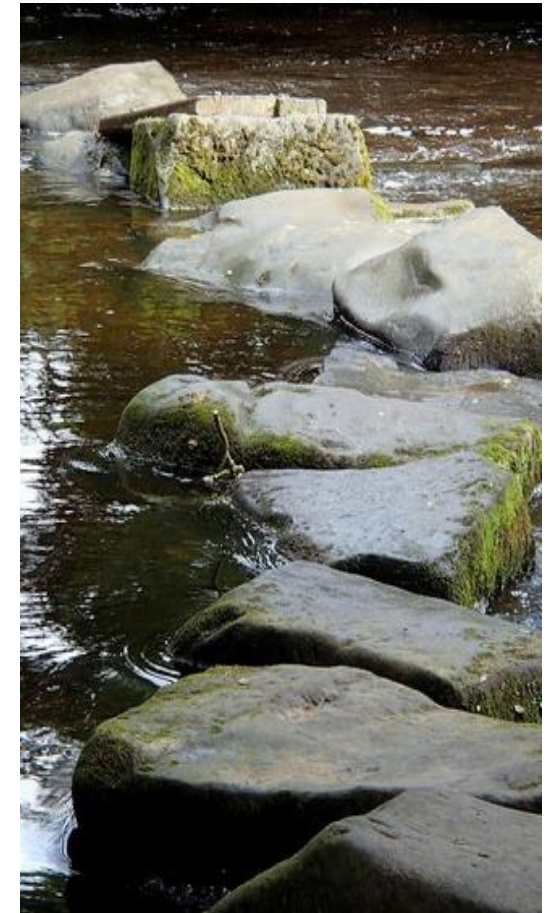

The following Prevention services are provided to families free of charge.

Please contact us for eligibility guidelines and referral information.

### ❖ *The Bridge School* Online Educational Services

The Bridge School provides online teachers, instructional materials and educational services for at-risk youth in grades 6-12. This program benefits students seeking credit recovery, a GED, or an educational alternative to the traditional school setting when remaining on campus is no longer a viable option.

### ❖ *Substance Abuse* Counseling

Youth in need of outpatient substance abuse treatment are evaluated through a free chemical assessment. Clinical services include outpatient Supportive, Intensive and Aftercare group therapy as well as individual and family therapy.

### *Katherine Crane, MS, LPC* Counseling Services

Rockwall County Juvenile Services has partnered with Crane Counseling Services to provide free mental health counseling for juveniles and family members.

Referred juveniles may receive up to 12 individual counseling sessions.

Group therapy and Parent Support are also available.

### Drug testing services for juveniles (ages 10-17)

- Please call at least 30 minutes ahead to schedule an appointment.
- Drug tests are generally available Monday-Friday, 8:30 – 11:30 a.m. and 1:00 – 4:30 p.m., excluding County holidays. Drug tests are not conducted on Tuesday mornings from 9 – 11 a.m.
- Youth should arrive ready to provide a urine sample. The test is a quick screen for a variety of substances including opiates, marijuana, cocaine, benzodiazepines, amphetamines and methamphetamines.
- Results are available within minutes of completing the test and are not confirmed by a laboratory.
- The cost of a drug test is \$ 6.00, payable only by check or money order. No cash, credit or debit cards are accepted for payment.
- If the test is positive, indicating substance abuse, it is strongly recommended that the juvenile seek counseling services.
