

MDLabTX COVID-19 Infusion Center Info Sheet

Key Points:

- The MDLabTX Infusion Center is located in Rockwall, TX.
- Patients must be referred by a physician. Patients cannot refer themselves.
- There is no "walk-in" availability; all treatments must be scheduled in advance.
- The MDLabTX Infusion Center utilizes the monoclonal antibody treatment Regeneron - COV (Casirivimab plus Imdevimab).
- This is a state-funded operation - there is no cost to the patient or referring provider.

I am a Physician - How Do I Refer a Patient for Infusion?

- Submit the completed form to BCFS.
 - By Email: infusion@mdlabs.com
- An Infusion Center Representative will reach out to the patient to schedule an appointment.

I am a Patient - How Do I get access to the MDLabTX Infusion Center?

- Visit a physician to see if you are eligible for Regeneron infusion.
 - You can be referred for infusion by a primary care physician, freestanding emergency department, or hospital.
- If your physician determines that you are eligible, they need to fill out and submit the Statewide RIC Infusion Center Referral Form.
- Once your physician has submitted your referral form, you will receive a call from the Regional Infusion Center to schedule an appointment.

Q: What documentation do I need to get the infusion?

A: You will need to provide a government-issued photo ID.

Q: Who can refer a patient to these infusion centers?

A: Physicians operating in Trauma Service Areas C, D, or E. There are no residency restrictions. Referrals can come from hospitals, Freestanding EDs and physician offices.

Q: What happens after a physician submits a patient referral?

A: An Infusion Center Representative will contact the patient to schedule the infusion appointment.

SUMMARY

MDLabTX has partnered with DSHS to create a state-funded MDLabTX Infusion Center in Rockwall, TX. This site will accept patient referrals from healthcare providers across TSAs C, D, and E to help administer COVID therapeutics quickly and safely with the goal of preventing patients from needing hospitalization.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Patients must meet at least ONE of the following criteria:

- Older age (for example, age \geq 65)
- Obesity or being overweight (for example, BMI $>$ 25 kg/m²)
- Pregnancy
- Chronic kidney disease, diabetes, or immunosuppressive disease
- Currently receiving immunosuppressive treatment
- Cardiovascular disease or hypertension
- Chronic lung diseases
- Sickle cell disease
- Neurodevelopment disorders
- Having a medical related technological dependence
- High risk Ethnicity Groups (Latino or Black)

Additionally, patients must meet ALL the following criteria:

- 12 years of age or older
- Patient is symptomatic (not asymptomatic) and has mild to moderate illness as noted by all of the following criteria:
 - Is not hospitalized due to COVID-19
 - Does not require oxygen therapy due to COVID-19
 - SpO₂% greater than 93% on RoomAir
- COVID symptoms present less than 10 days
- If on oxygen chronically, is on same rate
- Stable for home management/care
- Document positive COVID test performed
- Patient is:
 - Day 10 or less since symptom onset or testing positive.
 - If pregnant, cleared with OB/GYN Physician.
