There are two prompts for each month, you can choose which prompt or read 2 books to fulfill both!

"New Year, New You!"

Read a book that features a skill or hobby of interest to you

"Go the Distance"

Read a book that features a competition or inspiring feat

"The Odd Couple"

Read a book that features unlikely friends or an opposites attract scenario

"When Disaster Strikes"

Read a book that features a disaster: world-ending or personal

"Hit or Myth"

Read a book that features mythological characters

"Music to my Ears"

Read a book that features music in some way

"Topsy Turvy"

Read a book in a genre you don't typically read

"If the Shoe Fits"

Read a book with a unique perspective about exceptional characters or exceptional circumstances

"Space...the Final Frontier"

Read a book set in space or with time travel and/or space travel as a story element

"No Cliffs Notes Allowed"

Read a book that you should have read in high school or college but didn't

"Forever Young Adult"

Read a book from the YA section

"Destination Unknown"

Read a book set in another country or with traveling as a theme

"Sparks are Flying"

Read a book with characters in a steamy situation

"Blockbuster Hits"

Read a book with an existing or upcoming movie or series adaptation

"Hall Pass"

Read a book in which the primary setting is a school or place of higher learning

"Embrace your Inner Child"

Read a book written for children

"Murder and Mayhem"

Read a true crime book or a mystery novel

"One for All and All for One"

Read a book that is a collected work of short stories, essays, articles, poems, or letters

"Jump on the Banned Wagon"

Read a book that has been challenged

"Bump in the Night"

Read a book with supernatural characters such as a ghost, witch, werewolf, vampire, etc.

"Vintage Revival"

Read a book published at least 30 years ago

"Food for Thought"

Read a book in which food is a significant feature

"And the Winner is..."

Read an award-winning book (check with your librarian for help finding award lists)

"All Together Now"

Read a book that focuses on family dynamics
